Satisfactory Academic Progress Appeal

- 1) Students are required to maintain a level of academic progress as noted the BSC catalog, under Financial Aid. BSC is required by Sec. 484(c) of the Higher Education Act 1965, as amended to establish Standards of Satisfactory Progress for students receiving assistance through Title IV programs (Pell, Supplemental Educational Opportunity Grant, Federal Work-Study, State Grant, Perkins Loans, and Family Federal Student Loan Programs.) Satisfactory progress is not to be confused with "good standing". A student can meet BSC standards of "good standing" and be allowed to enroll but may not meet the minimum standards, "Satisfactory Progress", to receive financial aid while enrolled. If there are special circumstances, a student may appeal to the Financial Aid Committee for reconsideration. Documentation may be required. This form may also be used to appeal the loss of a BSC scholarship.

- a. GPA below the required overall 2.0 for an undergraduate student or GPA below the required overall 1.5 for a freshman; GPA below the requirement for renewal of a BSC scholarship.
- b. Completion rate is below the required 67% for all hours attempted, including failures, repeated and dropped courses, withdrawals, and incompletes.
